

### ***Outreach Volunteers – Ongoing Posting***

HIM's outreach programs offer a unique variety of different settings: street, drop-in, outdoors, events, venues and parties. Each of these venues involves different responsibilities, duties, and communities while still maintaining a common goal of health promotion, including harm reduction and benefit maximization. Outreach Volunteers work with staff to help implement special programming for an under-resourced community of gay men and other men who have sex with men by helping and meeting people in their own neighbourhoods. Time commitment is usually one or two days a week in the evening, as determined by need, availability and venue. In addition to outreach services, the HUSTLE program at HIM offers peer support to male-identified sex workers via street, drop-in, and online initiatives... working front-line with those who need support.
